Solid Scotia Beading – 2400mm

Key Features:

- Unika Solid wood scotia is designed to cover the expansion gap between the floor and skirting. This will ensure a perfect finish to all veneer, engineered and solid wood floors.
- Solid wood scotia is available in 2.4 metre lengths with a radius of 20mm. This radius is sufficient to cover the expansion gap set by the majority of solid wood flooring manufacturers.
- Solid wood scotia can be pinned or glued (using MultiFix) to skirting and is easily mitred.
- Produced from the same timber used in the profile range Solid Wood Scotia is available in the following species:
 1. American White Oak (available in lacquered and unlacquered)
 2. European Oak (lacquered)
 3. Canadian Maple (lacquered)
 4. Beech (lacquered)
 5. Kempas (Stained Beech – lacquered)
 6. Dark Cherry (Stained Beech – lacquered)
 7. Merbau (Stained Beech – lacquered)

8. Walnut (lacquered)
9. Walnut (Stained)
10. Carina Birch (Stained)
11. Ash

Directions for Use:

To Fix Unika Solid Wood Scotia in place, simply:

Measure and carefully cut the scotia to the correct length.

Place a bead of Unika MultiFix on the reverse of the scotia.

Hold in place until secure.

Wipe up any excess MultiFix with a clean damp cloth.
